CFR conducts research, which is incorporated into its community programs. The Transcending Trauma Project, a CFR research program since 1991, studies the lives of Holocaust survivors and their families in order to learn about the human response to extreme trauma. This research contributes to the field of mental health by providing essential knowledge for treating trauma victims. In addition to our research, CFR provides resources for the public on a variety of mental health topics. CFR's Operation Home and Healing offers specialized clinical training programs for mental health professionals and members of the clergy who work with military populations.

ABOUT TTP

The Transcending Trauma Project has produced 1,200 hours of in-depth life history interviews which have been preserved as digital archived files. The Phil Wachs and Juliet Spitzer Archive of the Transcending Trauma Project are housed at the U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum.

This is the only qualitative research project of its kind to look at pre-war and post-war factors, family dynamics, coping and adaptation strategies after the war, and the impact of severe trauma based on in-depth life history interviews with three generations of survivor families. 02

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
